I Delight In You

As we journey through Lent we continue to reflect upon our spiritual life. For some, Lent is a season of abstaining from certain practices in order to take on new rhythms and habits, whilst for others it is an opportunity to pick up new practices that bring life, connection and growth as part of the spiritual journey. I encourage you to consider this in the days ahead. What practices might you pick up or lay down as you explore your faith in a deeper way? Our sub-theme for Lent, **"A** *Lenten Refrain,"* speaks to the ways God can make music of our lives and over our lives. There is a beautiful passage in the Old Testament book of Zephaniah which describes God singing over us with joy:



"The Lord your God is with you, the Mighty Warrior who saves. He will take great delight in you; in his love he will no longer rebuke you, but will rejoice over you with singing." (Zephaniah 3:17)

The artwork above is titled, *"I Delight In You"* and was created by Lisle Gwynn Garrity. It is based on Jesus' baptism in Mark 1 and the divine voice speaking words over Jesus and naming him as Beloved. Lisle says:

"As soon as the water washes over him, creation is summoned to celebrate. I imagine [Jesus] wading into the waters and leaning back to receive the blessing that falls upon him like rain: You are my beloved."

This is a delightful display of God singing over Jesus with joy. In our gathering last Sunday I spoke these words:

"If you hear nothing else today, hear this: God is here. God sees you. God knows you. God meets you at the edge of every new beginning, And God calls you beloved."

My prayer is that as we engage in new practices or lay down others, we might be filled with the deep and grounded knowledge that we are known and loved by God. May you know and experience this deeply in your being. You are indeed loved!
