EMPLOYER PROFILE

Bangalow Byron Bay Uniting Church and Alstonville Uniting Church, sharing the message of Christ with young people and the community.

This new role is central to a Synod Growth Fund project which is a collaboration between Bangalow Byron Bay and Alstonville Uniting Churches and is a logical next step in developing the existing ministries, exploring new ministries and building stronger connections with local young people, families and community groups. Both churches are located in the Far North Coast Presbytery in a rural area and are at a distance of 25 minutes by car. There are some similarities, but the two congregations also have different dynamics and contexts.

Bangalow Byron Bay:

Bangalow Byron Bay Uniting Church is a joint congregation across two locations and for the purposes of this role and project the focus will be in the Bangalow community. The church premises are in a prime position in the centre of the Bangalow village, adjacent to the local public school. Bangalow is also the centre of business for a number of surrounding villages in the Hinterland just west of Byron Bay and so the location draws people from a wider geographic area. Bangalow Uniting Church has built a wonderful reputation in the community through its ministries. The outcome of engaging in the UME Growing Young Project in 2021 has resulted in a number of new initiatives and missional engagements focused on ministry to people in the first third of life. The congregation has a strategic focus for Bangalow of "Ministry to Families" (First Third of Life Ministry).

Alstonville:

Alstonville Uniting Church is centrally located on the main street of Alstonville, next to two primary schools and the entrance to the high school. It is in a prime location, just 150 metres from Alstonville Plaza - the centre of the local community for Alstonville, Wollongbar, Rous Mill, and the surrounding areas. Alstonville Uniting Church has been known in its community over the years for its vibrant ministries. Following extensive mission planning last year, the congregation is seeking to develop ministries specifically for the primary school age group (which will flow on from the current thriving Mainly Music program for pre-schoolers) with a focus on further engaging local families, communities, and schools.

ABOUT THE ROLE

The First Third of Life Ministry Coordinator (FTLM) is a Lay Specified Ministry role within the Uniting Church in Australia. The FTLM Coordinator will work equally across both Bangalow Byron Bay and Alstonville Uniting Churches to facilitate, lead, and grow ministries for people in the first third of life. This includes leading the existing Growing Young groups, creating community connections, and developing new ministry programs aligned with local needs.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Pastorally lead and coordinate the Growing Young groups at both congregations, facilitating collaboration, discipleship and shared learning.
- Develop and implement new ministry initiatives focused on engaging and discipling young people and families.
- Facilitate intergenerational and intercultural connections, exploring fresh expressions of church.
- Collaborate with both congregations' leadership and ministry agents to ensure strategic alignment and resource sharing.
- Organise family engagement events and community connection activities.
- Identify and respond to local community needs through faith-based programs and activities.
- Mentor and equip volunteers and church members for First Third of Life Ministry involvement.
- Maintain effective communication and reporting with both congregations and the Strategic Reference Group.
- Foster the development of potential young leaders.
- Following policy and procedures in relation to workplace health and safety
- Participating in maintaining a safe working environment for both yourself and others in the workplace
- Undertaking additional duties as directed

EVANGELISM OR SERVICE BEYOND A GATHERED CONGREGATION

- Explore ways of enhancing or implementing community outreach programs.
- Explore ways of better connecting and working with existing community groups beyond the church.
- Developing stronger connections with more local advertising and publicity.
